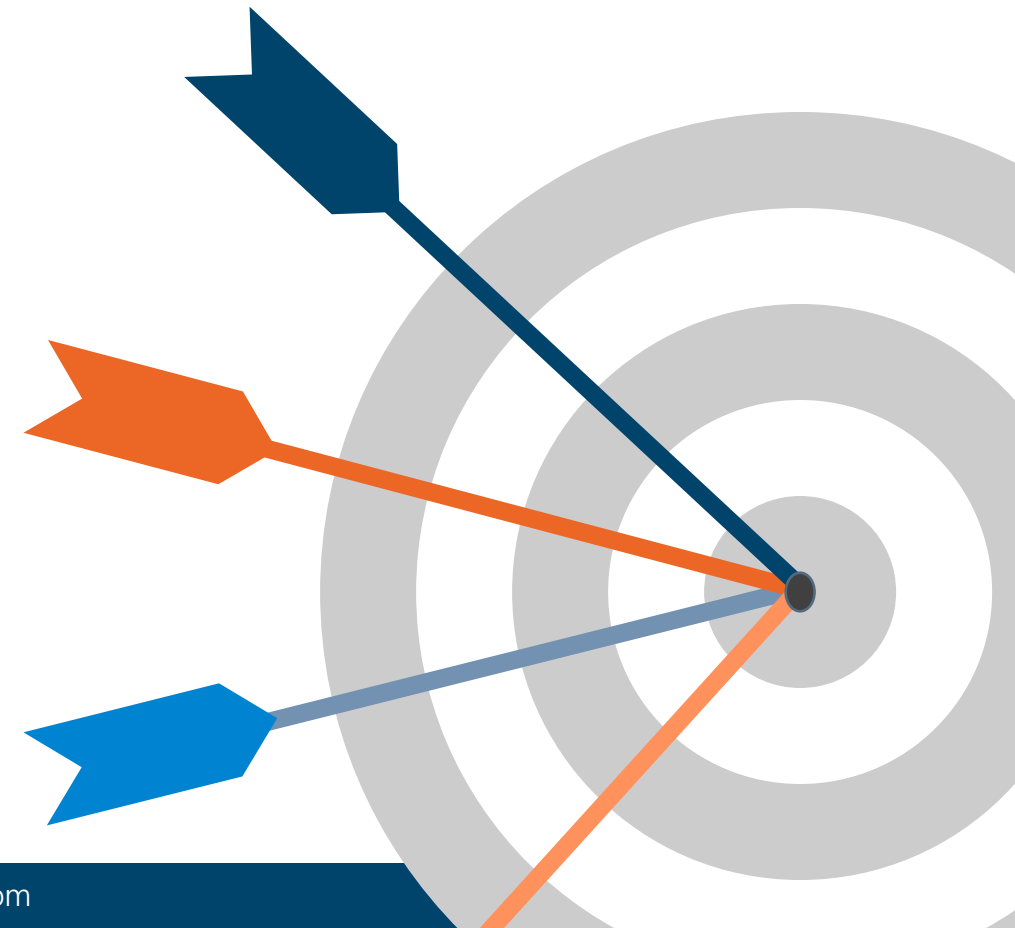

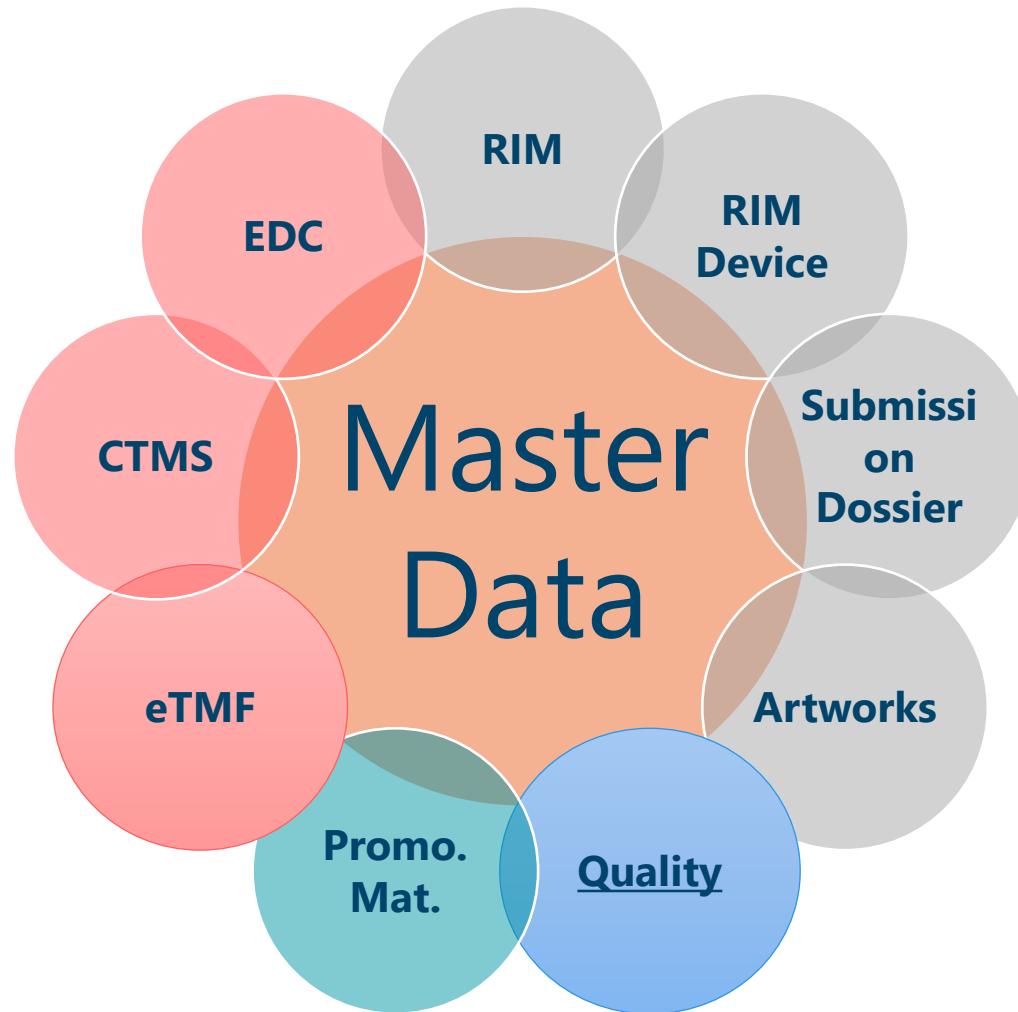

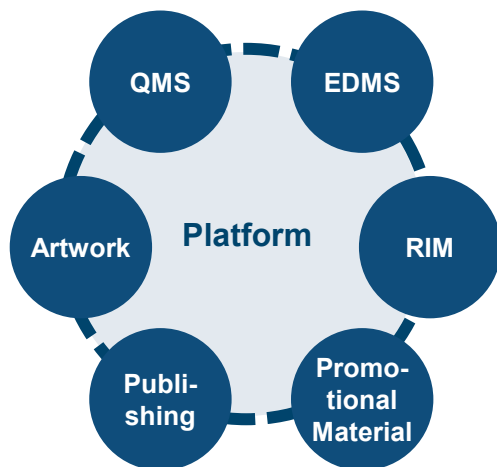

The concept of Ennov core models

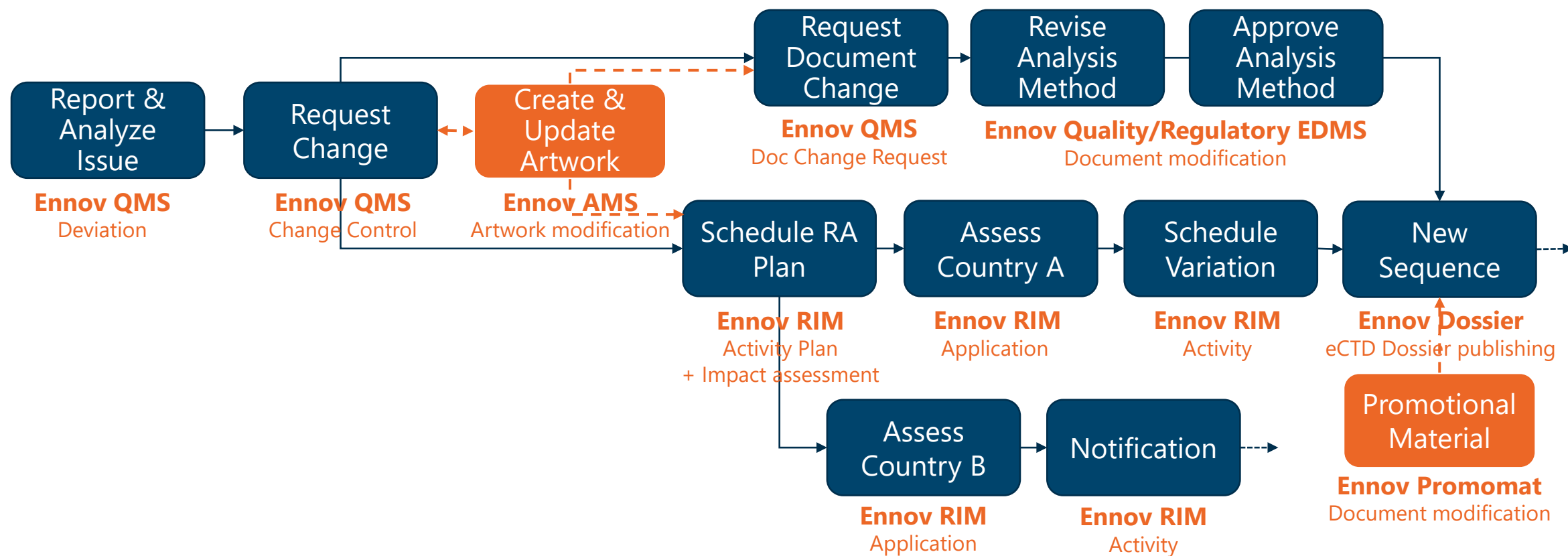


- › An Ennov Core Model is an **out-of-the-box** solution

Change Control – A Cross-domain workflow that benefits from unified data



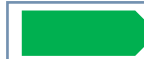


2 – Quality Roadmap

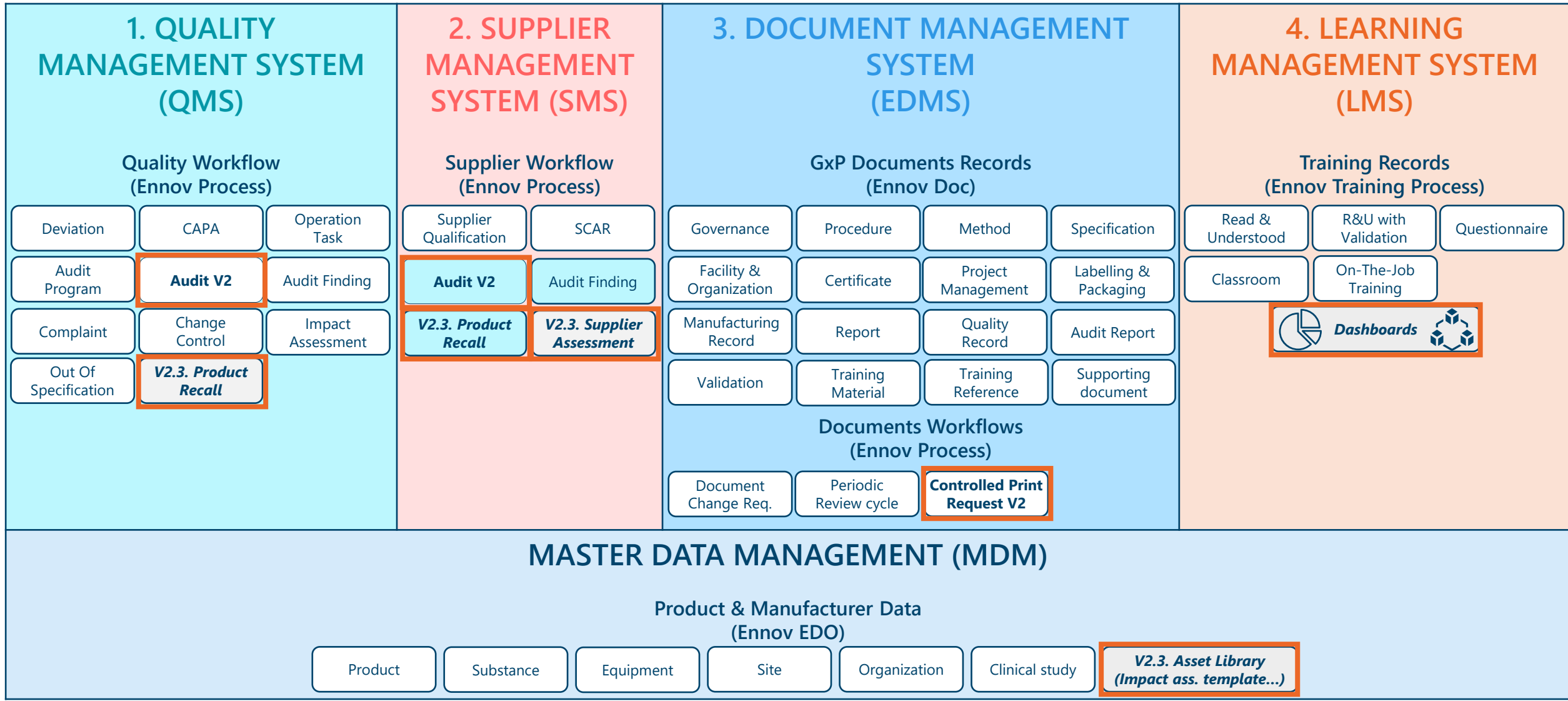

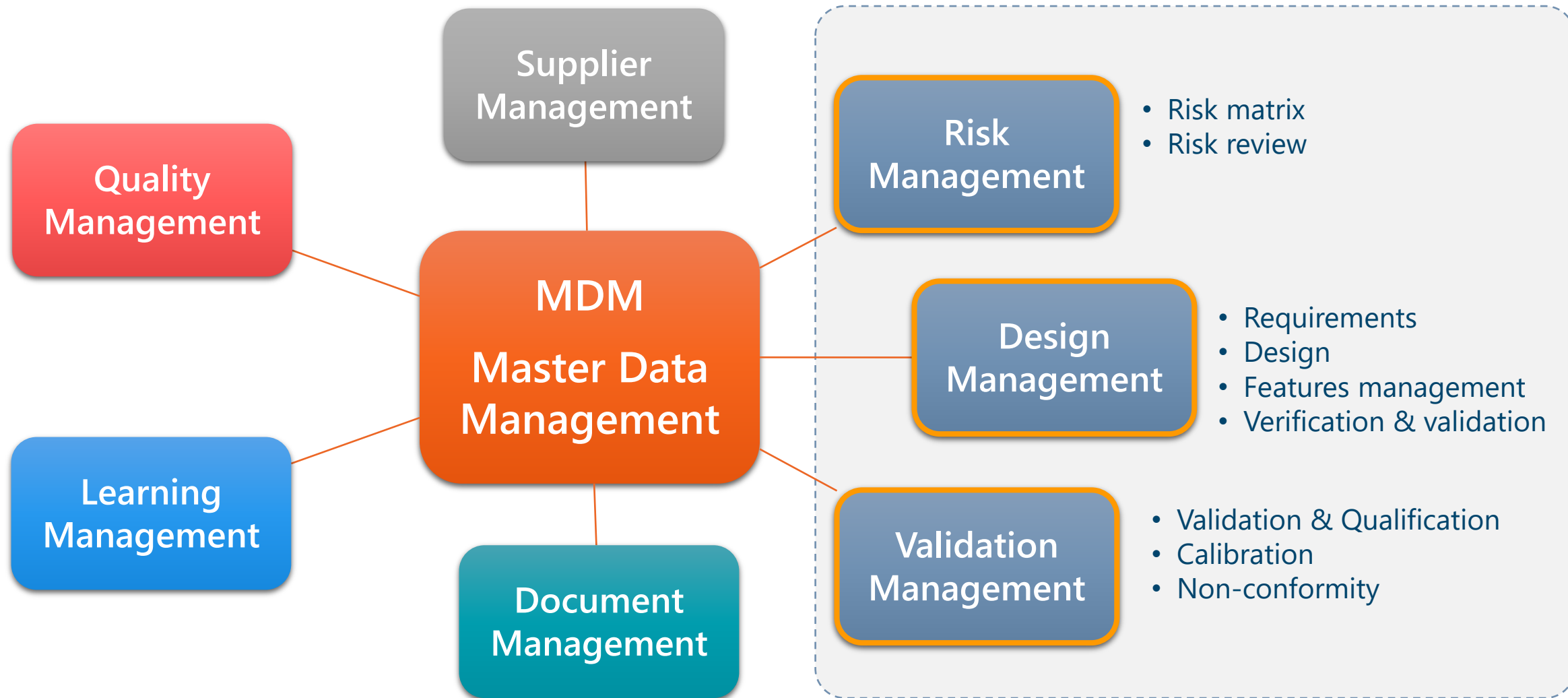

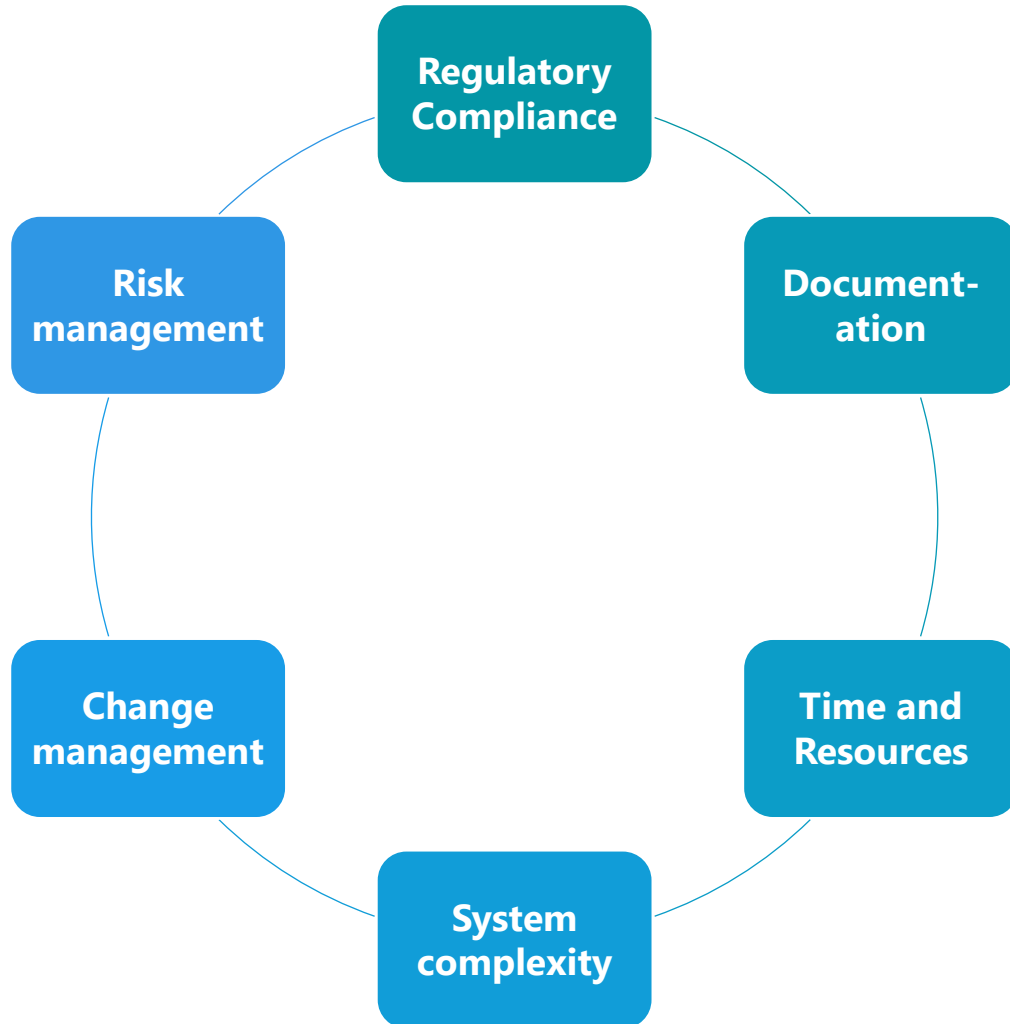
Quality Core Model v2.3 – October 2025



Quality Core Model v2.4 - 2026

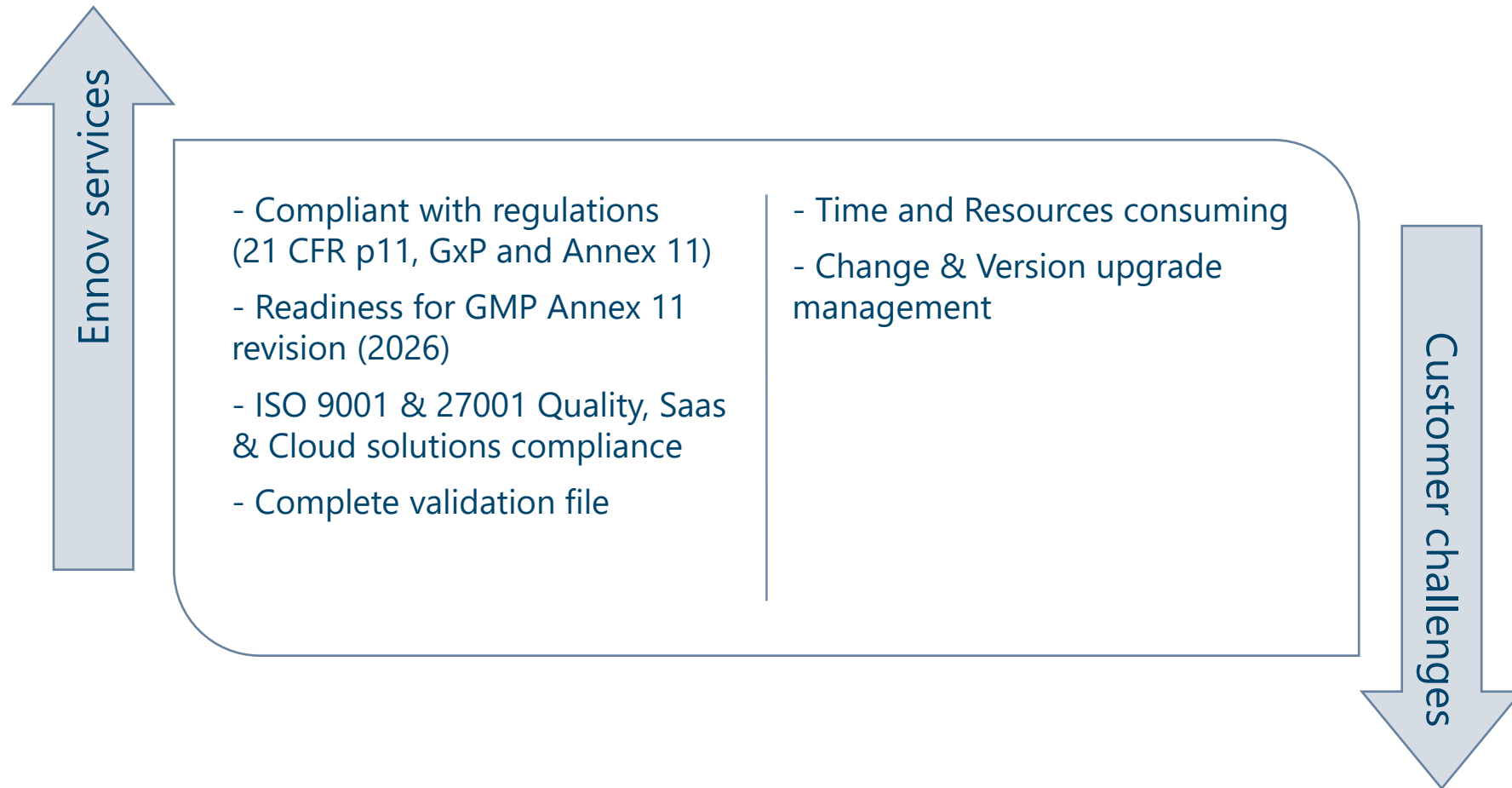


Computerized Software Validation challenges

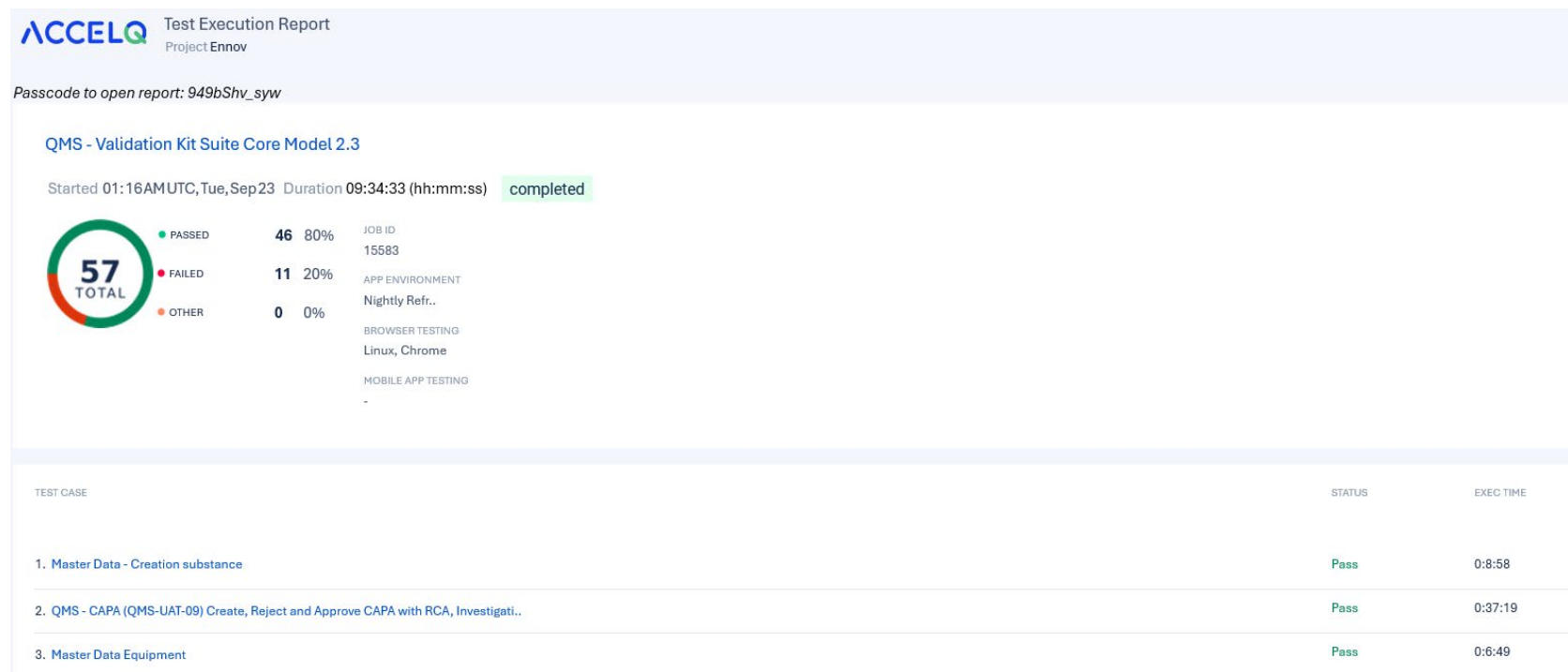

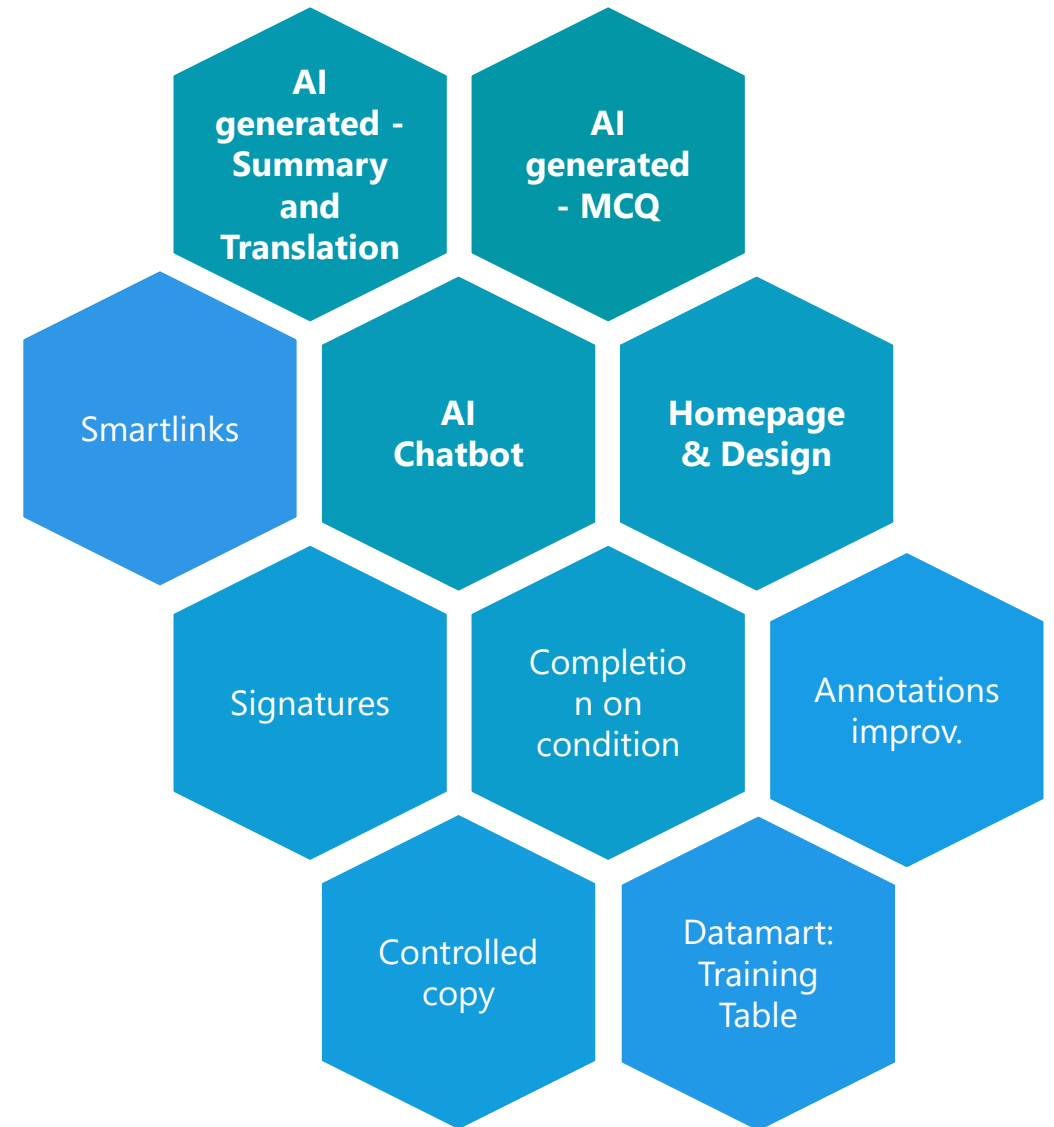

03 Annotations enhancements

- › PDF annotations available since V10
- › Reply to an annotation
- › Assign a status to an annotation
- › Filters in the annotations panel
- › Saving, retain and viewing intermediate versions



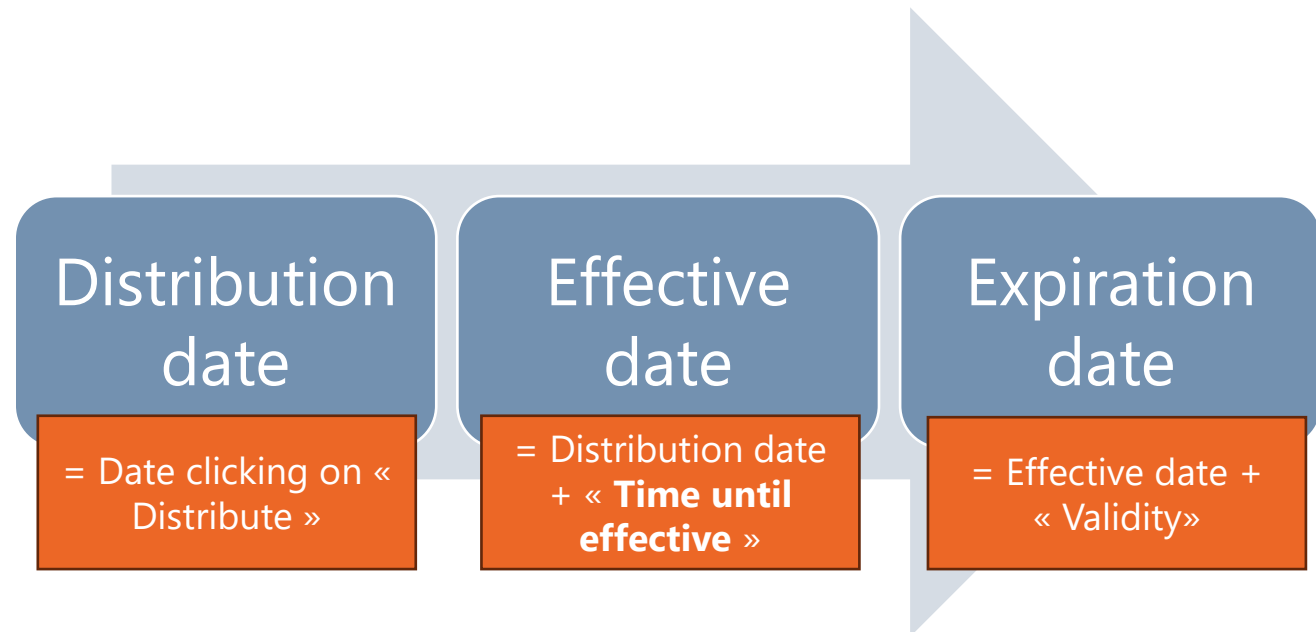

04 Signatory

- › 10.3 Certified Signature (subject to license)
 - › Adding an Adobe Approved Trust List certificate
 - › The signature certificate is downloaded with the document
 - › Can be used with Ennov TPS (external signature)
- › 10.3 User can modify their signature image from their profile menu
- › 10.4 Assign a function as signatory
- › 11.0 Option to allow a user to sign at several steps

05 Distribution timeline

- › Define a **standard time** between document distribution and effective date
- › Configurable option at Unit or Unit-Type level
- › The Date of distribution field can be added to the form

06 Archived document

- › 10.3 Redesign of Archived document form to improve visualisation
- › 10.3 Restricting access to an archived document
 - › Accessible metadata
 - › Access to document limited to issuer and admin
- › 10.4 Cancellation form: ability to exclude or include

07 Acknowledgement / read & Understood (doc)

- › Issuer and signatories: Now considered to have read and understood the document
- › No notification
- › No action in to do list
- › Acknowledgement / read & Understood = Distribution date

08 Hard copies management

- › **Identify, verify, secure and trace hard copies**
- › Substitute « Controlled print server » module
- › A set of new features,
 - › Overlayed document on request
 - › Enriching available bookmarks for overlaying (header/footer too)
 - › Overlay template management
 - › New object type in the Quality Core Model: Distribution point
- › Can be used with or without EDO and Smartlinks

09 Automatic table of contents update

- › Perform during converting a Word document (with Conversion Server)
 - › Conversion format: Bookmark only or PDF
 - › The document must include a table of contents
- › Execution step:
 - › Draft conversion
 - › Send for approval
 - › Distribution

10 New AI features

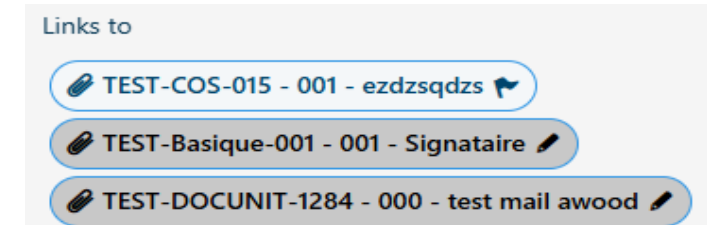


- › 1 - Documents translation
- › 2 - Documents summary
 - › Create or view "translated" content
 - › Languages supported to date
 - › French, German, English, Chinese, Danish, Spanish, Italian, Japanese, Dutch, Polish, Portuguese, Russian
 - › Other languages on request
- › Subject to license (AI)

11 Various eDoc enhancements

- › “Links to”: possible now to link document(s) not yet effective




- › “Integrate an existing document”: ability to hide button



12 Various eDoc enhancements

- › Version
 - › Label update, "Revision" => "Version"
 - › Version number is no longer editable (option in properties)
- › Document created from a template
 - › Autonoming
"[P_REF]_[P_REVISION]_[P_TITLE].extension"
(limited to 50 characters)
- › Source backup
 - › Automatically performed when a contributor checks in the document

13 Improvements to the polling step

- › New options for interrupting a voting step
- › 1 - Stop as soon as the polling cannot be successful
 - › Example: 3 voters, 100% positive votes
 - › Voter 1 : Yes => continue
 - › Voter 2: No => stop (failure)

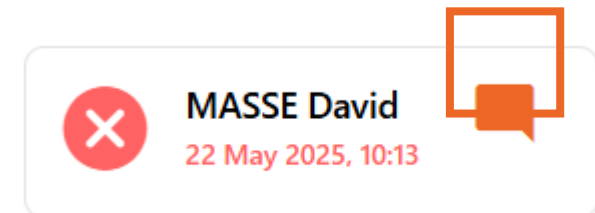

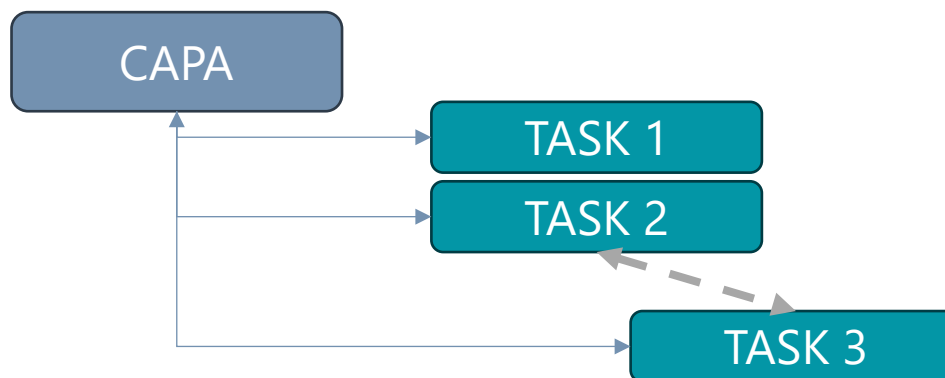
- › 2 – Interrupt button for unit administrator

14 Completion on condition

- › To automatically execute a "Complete" for the current step
- › Replace automatic step "WaitForSubProcess"
- › Illustration of a use case:
 - › Complete CAPA only when all associated tasks have been completed
 - › Managing dependencies between tasks

16 Business table and dashboards

- › New generic table: Training
- › Available to all (if training module)
- › Allow to create Training Dashboards
 - › Included in the Quality Core Model
- › New widget: Cross table => Skills matrix

18 Users

- › Duplicate a user's profile and roles
 - › From a source user to a target user
 - › No copying of personal data, audit trail and license
- › Re-activate a user
 - › Button to display archived users
 - › Re-activate button

19 Smartlinks

- › Creation tag also available in creation mode
 - › New attribute « subObject » if true,
 - › Visible in edition mode
 - › Auto close
 - › If « visibleViewMode = true », creation tag also available in consultation mode
- › Automatic update of reverse link in parent process process

20 Comment

- › New predefined values available for comment recipients:
 - › Recipients (Doc + Process)
 - › Contributors, Proofreaders (Doc)
 - › Signatories (Doc)
 - › Current Step's candidates (Process)
 - › Current Step's manager (Process)
